Artist affiliates can voluntarily participate in GITC in a variety of ways, such as:

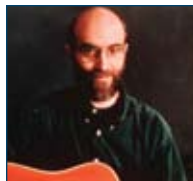
1. Plan school visits, concerts and workshops at schools through the GITC network of trainers, dealers, classroom teachers, parents and street teams.
